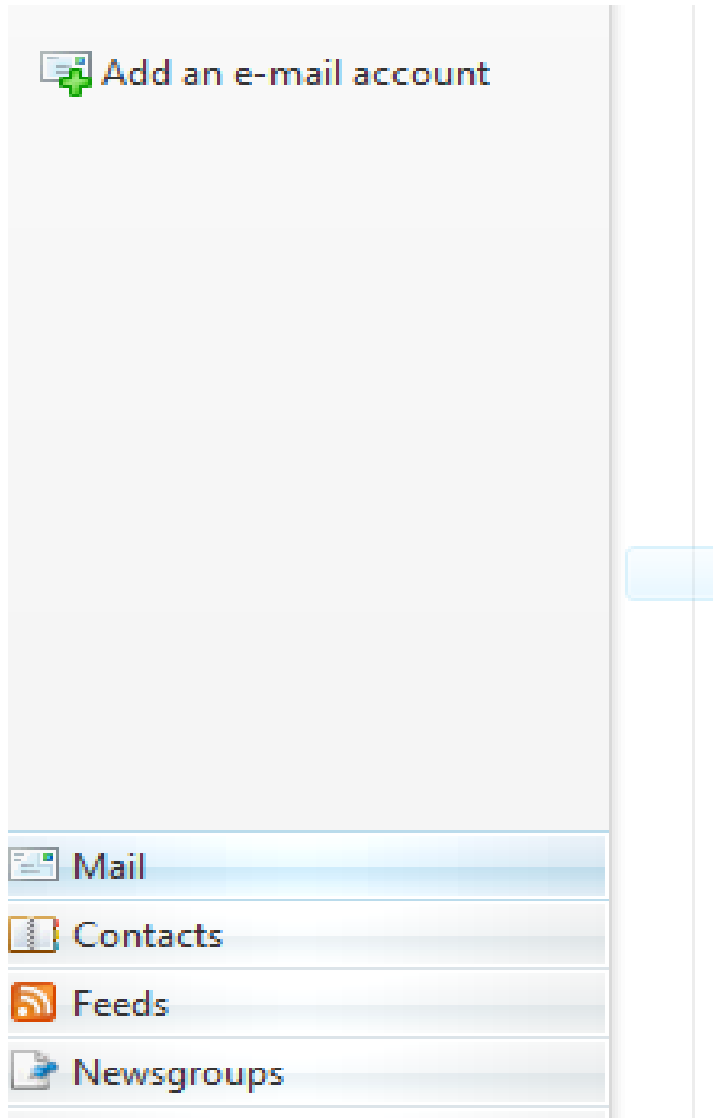





## MyMail<sup>SM</sup> Setup Instructions for Windows Live Mail

---

1. Click Add an e-mail account in the left hand panel.



2. Enter your email address in the “E-mail address:” field
3. Enter your password in the “Password:” field
4. Enter your name in the “Display Name:” field
5. Check the box beside “Manually configure server settings for e-mail account”
6. Click Next
